

# PORTUGUESE HARLEQUIN

<b>BODY</b> <b>(shape)</b> <b>CHEST</b> <b>WINGS</b> <b>20</b>	<b>Body</b> Long, thin, slightly visible shoulders. <b>Chest</b> Slightly rounded. <b>Back</b> Thin, straight, in the same line of the tail. <b>Wings</b> Long, carried closed to the body without crossing or falling.
<b>CREST</b> <b>HEAD</b> <b>NECK</b> <b>15</b>	<b>Crest (Crested Harlequin)</b> - Triangle shaped crest (2 angles at the back and 1 virtual at the front) coming from a central point at the top of the head and then falling symmetrically without covering the eyes and the beak. <b>Head (Pair Harlequin)</b> - Long and thin, straightening the skull towards the beak. <b>Beak</b> - Strong and proportionate. <b>Eyes</b> - Bright and well visible. <b>Neck</b> - Well molded, pointing out very clearly the head and body.
<b>SIZE</b> <b>15</b>	16 cm.
<b>COLOUR</b> <b>15</b>	Evenly variegated and multicolored. Simultaneous presence of lipochrome red and white. Artificial colouring mandatory.
<b>PLUMAGE</b> <b>10</b>	Compact, smooth, silky, glossy and adherent to the body.
<b>POSITION</b> <b>MOVEMENT</b> <b>10</b>	Erect standing (60°) and haughty. Elevated body. Alert and jaunty, moving confidently.
<b>LEGS AND TAIL</b> <b>10</b>	<b>Legs</b> Strong, long, slightly bent and preferably variegated. Well visible thighs. <b>Tail</b> Long, thin, slightly bifurcated at the tips and preferably variegated.
<b>GENERAL CONDITION</b> <b>5</b>	Clean and healthy. Liveliness and good adaptation to the show cage.
